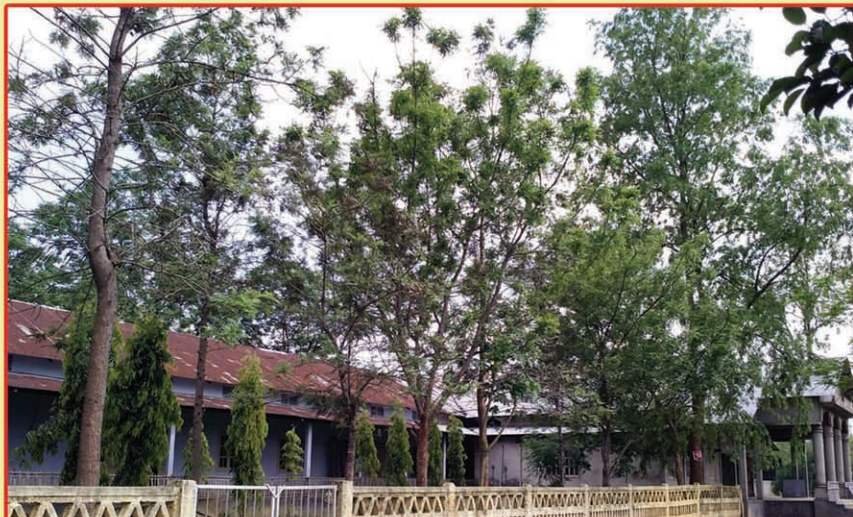
The college is Permanently Affiliated to Gauhati University and Concurred by Govt. of Assam. It is also registered under the Society Act. 1860

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ABOUT THE COLLEGE



A) History of the College

On an auspicious occasion on 22nd day of August, 1996, the Agia College makes its existence temporarily at J. N. Memorial H.S. School building, Agia as a Degree Arts College under the Presidentship of Late Mahesh Ch. Nath, Secretaryship of Late Swahid Ray and Principalship of Late Dr. Monoj Kumar Chakraborty, with five lecturers and twenty nine students. Before its establishment the need for a Degree Arts College at Agia had for long been igniting the minds of the people here and also the remote neighbouring areas, as there were no college within a radius of 12 to 15 kms. the need for such higher Institution has been seriously felt.

Accordingly, the first meeting was held at Agia on 24th January, 1982 being chaired by Late Nibharsha Singha of Solmari Village and resolution taken unanimously on it. It was under the circumstances that a demand for setting up of Degree Arts College arose some years back to cater the needs of a large number of the aspiring youths along with the responsibilities of 10 (ten) Goan Panchayat areas with the population of about 1.25 Lakhs.

A group of social worker, educationist of the locality viz. Late Kiran Ch. Nath, Late Bhabendra Narayan Ray, Sri Hemen Ray, Sri Sushil Kr. Roy, Sri Padma Bahadur Gurung, Sri Jaychandra Nath, Sri Sirish Das, Sri Dhiraj Das, Sri Dhaneswar Das, Sri Dibya Lochan Das, Late Subhash Kalita, Smti Nalini Bala Das, Smti Kanika Das, Late Dharani Das, Late Arabinda Das, Late Nripen Das, Sri Sushil Rabha, Sri Motilal Rabha, Sri Kiran Rabha, Sri Tapan Das and many other enthusiastic people were always in active participation to push forward and to fulfil the noble dream of the greater locality. Among them, Sri P.B. Gurung and Sri Sushil Kr. Roy had carried the pain of being the Secretary and President of the Managing Committee and Governing body accordingly.

Mr. Hareswar Sutradhar, M. A., B. T. (Retired Principal of J.N.M. H.S. School), Late Karuna Kanta Rabha, M.A. (Retired Principal of Dudhnoi College) and Mr. Rohit Kr. Sarma, M.A., M.Phil. (Retired Professor of Goalpara College) has shouldered the responsibility of the college as Principal till 31 July, 2005 accordingly after departure of Dr. Monoj Kr. Chakraborty.

However, the college is presently imparting education in the newly constructed permanent building. The class room and other room are also arranged according to the guideline of University.

The dream to build a permanent building came true with the upstream co-operation from the member of the sponsoring Body of the College, hard labour and whole-hearted will of the erstwhile Secretary Late Swahid Ray, a group of sympathetic and enthusiastic people of the locality, financial grants from MP and MLA funds, i.e. Sri Drupad Buragohain (Ex M.P. Rajya Sabha), Mr. Anowar Hussain (Ex. MP Dhubri Constituency), Sri. Jyotish Das and Sri Dulal Ch. Ghosh (Ex. MLA 37 Goalpara East Constituency respectively) along with local bodies like Kalyanpur Gaon Panchayat and Rabha Hasong Autonomous Council helped the college for stepping forward to achieve the goal. Besides the ceaseless effort and dignity of the past and present Managing Committee & Governing Body of the College accordingly are also noteworthy for progression of the college.

With the modest beginning in 1996, the college is now marching forward for its Silver Jubilee year. The college has been emerging as a centre of quality education. Yet, it is felt that to meet the future challenges; the college must walk in planned root. Hopefully it is expected by proper implementation of future plans and programmes, the college will find a new vista in catering the challenges of modern education considering the needs of the region by introducing new vocational course.

The first batch of student appeared B.A. final examination in the year 1999 and till last year a good number of students have passed B.A. from this college and rendering services in various fields.

B) Status of the College:

The College is permanently affiliated to Gauhati University and concurred by the Govt. of Assam. It is also registered under the Society Act. 1860.

C) Location of the College:

The College is situated on the southern part of the mighty river Brahmaputra and on east side of the National Highway No. 37 between Agia and Solmari in a very natural environment under 37 LAC. It is far from 10 (ten) Km's away from the district head quarter of Goalpara on the edge of "Urpada Bil", the pictures of infinite beauty.

H) Courses of Study:

The College offers Three Year Degree Course in Honours (earlier known as Major) and Regular (earlier known as General) subjects.

I) Subjects offered:

- a) For Honours/Major Course: Assamese, Education, Economics and Political Science.
- b) For Regular/General Course: Assamese, English, Education, Economics, History, and Political Science.
- c) For Ability Enhancement Compulsory Course (AECC): English Communication/ MIL Communication (Assamese)/ Environmental Science
- d) Discipline Specific Elective (DSE): Assamese, Education, Economics, History, Political Science.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Application for admission into the college should be submitted in the prescribed Form obtainable from the college website, www.agiacollege.co.in. Admission is free in TDC 1st Semester for candidates of Assam domicile. Application should be supported by the requisite documents i.e. Marks Sheet, Pass Certificate, Caste Certificate, Registration Certificate, Bank Account details, Birth Certificate/ PRC/ Voter ID/ Aadhar Card Gap/BPL Card / Passport, Certificate/ Affidavit, Migration Certificate (if any) etc. Original Migration Certificate must be submitted by the candidate who has passed H.S. from other than AHSEC to the college office after confirming the admission. Once the data submitted by the candidates the cannot be changed during their tenure in the college.

On the basis of the Applications received, the list of selected candidates for Regular Course and Honours Course will be published in online prior to the date of admission. If the candidates applied for Honours course are not selected for the same will be selected to Regular Course on the basis of the cut off marks. On the basis of Selection list for Admission into TDC 1st Semester (Arts), candidates have to confirm his/her admission through online to the college. The selected candidates must get themselves admitted within the dates fixed for admission, failing which they shall forfeit their claim for admission.

Fresh candidates have to take admission into TDC 1st Semester. Accordingly, the candidates are to be admitted into the 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th Semester after every six months respectively by depositing the dues to the college. Students who do not enroll in the next semester will not be allowed for admission to the following semesters.

Eligibility Criteria for Admission into TDC 1st Semester (Arts):

- (i) Should pass 12th Class from recognised Board/Council/University.
- (ii) Gap should not exceed 5 (five) years, i.e. should completed 12th class on or after 2015.

Medium of Teaching :

The medium of teaching is either Assamese or English in Regular Subjects and the Medium of teaching is English in Honours Subjects (except the Honours in Language subject)

College Dues for Mid-term admission:

Students have to be admitted into the even semesters i.e. 2nd, 4th and 6th Semester by depositing the requisite fees to the college as per notification published by the college authority in due course of time.

Registration to the concerned University:

As the Agia College is affiliated to Gauhati University, hence every student admitted in this college have to be registered themselves under the affiliating university to continue the course for which the student has been admitted for. The process of Registration starts in online as per the notification published by the concerned university. Students have to pay through online the necessary Registration fee to the concerned university.

Note : Student's who migrate from other University/Board/Council are to pay the eligibility Fees in addition to their Registration Fee for their respective registration as per fee regulation of Gauhati University.

COURSES AND PROGRAMMES

The College offers the Three Year Degree Course (TDC) in Arts (Semester basis) following the Under Graduate Choice Based Credit System (UGCBCS) under Gauhati University from the Academic Session 2019-2020. The Three Years Degree Course will be of Six Semesters covering three calendar years. Two consecutive (one odd and one even) semester will make up an academic year. First, Third & Fifth semesters are Odd semesters and Second, Fourth & Sixth semesters are Even semesters. The Minimum time requirement for the undergraduate Degree Course will be three years and the Maximum time allowed to complete the course is six years.

Subjects offered for Three Years Degree Course (Honours and Regular):

The College offers Honours (earlier known as Major) and Regular (earlier known as General) Course in Arts stream. The students may opt Honours in the following subjects:

1) Assamese

2) Education

3) Economics

4) Political Science

Simultaneously, the students may opt Regular Courses in the following subjects:

1) Education

2) Economics

3) Elective Assamese

4) History

5) Political Science

In addition to the above subjects, students of Honours and Regular Course have to study some papers as Ability Enhancement Compulsory Course (AECC), Skill Enhancement Course (SEC). For details students may study the Programme Templates for Honours Course & Regular Course.

KEY POINTS OF THE B.A. HONOURS COURSE UNDER CBCS

- In undergraduate Honours course a student have to study 14 Core Papers of the subject concern carrying 6 credits each. Two (2) Core Papers in each Semester of 1,2,5,& 6 and Three (3) Core Papers in each Semester of 3 & 4 are to be studied by a B.A. Honours student.
- The Students of B.A. Honours Course have to study Two (2) papers as Ability Enhancement Compulsory Course (AECC) for Semester of 1 & 2 (One paper for one Semester) carrying 4 credits each. The two compulsory AECC papers are English/MIL Communication and Environmental Science. A student is to select any one paper for a particular semester but not the same paper in both the Semesters.
- An undergraduate Honours Course student have to study Four (4) Generic Elective (GE) Papers in Semester 1,2,3 & 4 (One paper in each Semester). Each GE Paper will carry 6 credits. The papers will be as per the prescribed syllabus of Gauhati University.
- The students shall require to study Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) one in each Semester 3 & 4. Each paper will carry 4 credit. The students shall have to study ENGLISH as a mandatory paper in Semester 3 as SEC-1. For Semester 4, the SEC-2 paper will be decided by the college as per the Gauhati University syllabus.
- The Honours Course students shall have to study the Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) which will be of 4 papers. Students shall study 2 papers in 5th Semester as well as 2 papers in 6th semester. Each DSE paper will carry 6 credits. The DSE papers will be according to the syllabus of Gauhati University. All students enrolled in B.A. Honours course will have the option of choosing to undertake Project/Dissertation work for 6 credits in lieu of a 6 credit DSE course in the 5th Semester only.

KEY POINTS OF THE B.A. REGULAR COURSE UNDER CBCS:

- In undergraduate Regular course a student have to study 12 Core course carrying 6 credits each. Where Two (2) DSC Papers in each Semester of 1,2,3 & 4 carrying 6 credits each along with English in Semester 1 & 2 carrying 6 credits each and MIL / Alt English in Semester 3 & 4 carrying 6 credits each.
- In Semester 1 & 2 students of Regular Course have to study Ability Enhancement Compulsory Course (AECC) one paper in both the semester 1 & 2 carrying 4 credits in each paper. English Communication / MIL Communication or Environmental Science will be as AECC where students have to choose any one paper for one semester but not the same paper in both semesters.
- A student opting Regular course have to study 4 Skill Enhancement paper in semester 3, 4, 5 & 6 (one in each semester) carrying 4 credits in each paper. The SEC paper will be decided by the college as per the Gauhati University syllabus.
- The students of Regular course shall have to study 4 Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) paper, two in each of Semester 5 & 6. Each DSE papers will carry 6 credits.
- Students have to study two Generic Elective (GE) as the GE-1 for semester 5 and GE-2 for Semester 6. The GE papers will carry 6 credit in each.

Two Numbers of the DSC papers will be continued as DSC-1C and DSC-2C.
[MIL(As)/ Alternative English will be continued up-to 4th semester.]

Skill Enhancement Course (SEC)

In 3rd Semester, students have to study one paper as Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) and the paper is SEC-1. **This SEC-1 paper will be decided by the authority in due course of time and the SEC paper will be continued up-to 6th Semester.**

In 4th Semester, students have to study 1 paper under Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) as SEC-2. **This SEC-2 paper will be decided by the authority in due course of time.**

CREDIT AND ATTENDANCE

- Credit is to be earned by the students in full and not in fraction
- Gauhati University set minimum 75% attendance in class as the requirement to earn full credit.
- Without 75% attendance, the students will be debarred from attending in End Semester Examination.
- The debarred students will continue their studies till final semester.
- After completion of attending the others External Semester Examination (ESE)s, the debarred students will have to attend the classes to earn the required credits for the debarred semester.
- Only then, they will be allowed to appear in both Internal as well as the External Semester Examination of debarred semester.

EVALUATION

A student's performance will be evaluated throughout the year based on continuous assessment. Evaluation of the students performance in each Semester for every course / paper will be based on the following:

- Internal Assessment (IA)
- End Semester Examination (ESE)

INTERNAL ASSESSMENT

Internal Assessment will ideally account for 20% of the total marks allotted to a course / paper. This 20% will be again divided in the following sections:

- a) A Sessional or mid-term examination will be conducted for 50% of the total marks allotted for Internal Assessment of a course / paper
- b) 20% of the marks allotted for Internal Assessment will be awarded to the students based on class attendance. If the total marks for Internal Assessment is 20, then 4 marks will be awarded to the students based on class attendance. In this case following criteria will be adopted:
 - 1) Class attendance from 76% to 80% = 1 Mark
 - 2) Class attendance from 81% to 85% = 2 Marks
 - 3) Class attendance from 86% to 90% = 3 Marks
 - 4) Class attendance from 91% and above = 4 Marks
- c) Rest 30% of the marks allotted for Internal Assessment will be distributed and awarded on the basis of performance of the students on the following criteria:
 - 1) Home Assignments
 - 2) Seminar / Group discussions
 - 3) Field Work
 - 4) Performance in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.

For smooth conduct of the Internal Examinations of the College an examination Board constituted with the Vice-principal as its permanent convener and the other members which will be appointed from time to time by the Principal.

END SEMESTER EXAMINATION (ESE)

The ESE will comprise 80% of the total marks earmarked for a course. The ESE shall be of three hours duration for a course whose ESE component exceeds 50 marks. For a student to pass in a course / paper, he/she has to pass in both Internal Assessment and End Semester Examination separately.

All ESE will be conducted and evaluated by the Gauhati University as per concern Examination Rules and procedure of Gauhati University. The existing Rules and Regulations of Gauhati University Act, 1949 (as amended time to time) will be applicable for any other academic matter.

FACILITIES

Library :

The college provides library and reading room facilities to the students as well as for the teachers with good quantity of books. In addition to the books supporting to the syllabus of each semesters, Magazine, Journals and News Papers are regularly subscribed in the college library. The students can borrow books from the library through his/her library Membership Card. For library membership card, an application to the librarian should be submitted in the prescribed format obtainable from the college library. All members have to follow the rules and regulations of the college library in all respect relating to the College Library. Borrowers must return the books within the given period and are personally responsible for the loss and damage of any book borrowed.

Students' Aid Fund :

This fund is kept to help the economically poor students on the basis of merit, attendance and regular observation subject to the availability of fund. Needy student are to apply to the Principal, enclosing necessary certificates from the competent authority and following necessary procedure framed for this purpose. The settlement is subject to the satisfaction of the college authority.

Common Room :

Separate Common Room facilities for both Boys' and Girls' are available including necessary accommodation and time consuming units.

NSS Unit :

Interested students may join in the National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit which will provide them not only the opportunities to render social services both inside and outside the college but also to develop personality under the guidance of a trained NSS Programme officer. The students may build themselves with the motto NOT ME BUT YOU.

Sports and Gymnasium :

The college provides sports and gymnasium facilities for physical training of the students to keep their body and mind fresh.

Career Guidance and Counsel Cell :

A career Guidance and Counsel Cell is run by the college for providing necessary guidance & information to the students under the leadership of an experienced coordinator appointed by the college authority.

Govt. Scholarship

The College is enlisted in the Govt. Scholarship Portal for Scholarship and students of this college belong to Schedule Caste, Schedule Tribe (P) & (H), Other Backward Classes, More Other Backward Classes and Minority are awarded Post Matric Scholarship by concerned Govt. authority on the basis of their application. Students will get the scholarship to their submitted account directly from the Govt. concerned department.

Special Felicitation:

The student accorded the highest mark among the students of Agia College appeared in the B. A. Final examination without having any arrear/back in any semester will be felicitated every year in the general meeting held for celebration of the Foundation Day of the college.

Students Union and Activities:

The Agia College Students' Union is the general body of the students of this college. Its membership is compulsory for every regular student admitted in the college. The Office bearers of the union are democratically elected for tenure of one year by the regular members. For all round development of the students, the Students' Union Body organizes various co-curricular and extra-curricular activities and competitions with the active guidance of teacher in-charge and the interested students may participate in such activities. The members of the Student Union have to wear the uniform specially designed for.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

College Uniform:

The students should wear the prescribed college uniform inside the college campus. No student is allowed to attend the classes without the prescribed uniform. The colour code of the uniform for boys are black long pant, light yellow shirt in summer and with black sweater in winter. Like, for girls black Pant (payjama), light yellow Kamij (should cover shoulder to knee), black Dopatta/Worm for summer and with black sweater in winter. It is for special attention that **Jacket, Summer Coat, Scarp, leggings are not allowed to wear as college uniform.**

N.B. : It is compulsory to wear uniform during the examination period.

Identity Card

A non transferable Identity Card is issued to each student in every session for a period of one year containing relevant information of the card holder together with a recent stamp size photograph. The Identity is issued on the basis of realization of Data sheet from the student. Students must carry valid Identity Card in the College campus.

Attendance of Students

A student must attend at least 75% of the lectures delivered in each subject to become eligible for appearing in the University Examinations. The scholarship holders must attend at least 80% of the lectures delivered in each subject for the renewal of their scholarships. Percentage of attendance for all required purpose will be counted from the date of beginning of regular classes.

MAINTENANCE OF DISCIPLINE

In matters of healthy practices, the college gives high priority to adhere the rules and regulations of the college for maintenance of discipline in the college campus. Every student is expected to abide by these rules and regulations. The following rules have been framed in this direction :

(i) Use of mobile or cellphones inside the Academic Block by students is strictly prohibited.

(ii) Ragging is human rights abuse in a essence. All forms of ragging in college campus are prohibited. Strong disciplinary action will be taken if any student is found to be involved directly or indirectly in ragging. As per recommendation of the R.K. Raghavan Committee, the following punishments will be imposed if any students is found to be indulged or provoking ragging in the college campus.

- a) Suspension from attending the class
- b) Rustication from the college
- c) Expulsion from the college.

(iii) Students must not loiter in the corridors so as to disturb other classes. The college authority may take strong action for this regard.

(iv) Students must maintain silence and discipline in the reading room of the library. In no way they should indulge gossiping and nonacademic activities. Violation of this norms may lead to cancellation of library membership.

(v) Students must follow uniform dress code during college hours.

(vi) Students must carry valid Identity Cards in the college days.

(vii) Consumption of Gutka, Panmasala or any other intoxicants in the college campus is strictly prohibited.

(viii) Students shall park their own bicycle, bike, car etc. at their own risks.
